DIRECTIONS

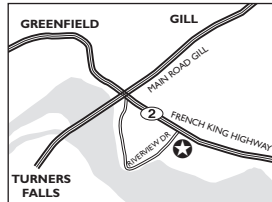
FROM THE EAST: Route 2 West 2.9 miles past the French King Bridge.
